Population **grew by 47** over the last 5 years but is projected to **decrease by 13** over the next 5 years.

Median household income is **\$18.8K below** the national median household income of \$57.7K.

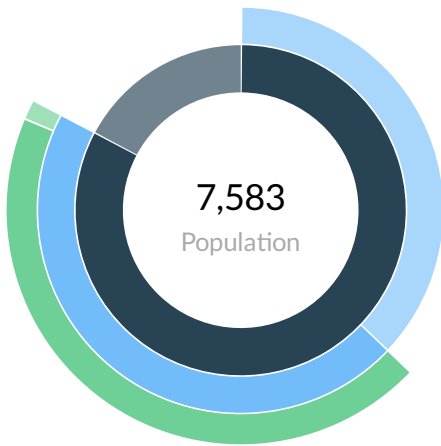
Takeaways

- As of 2018 the region's population **increased by 0.6%** since 2013, growing by 47. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.2%** between 2018 and 2023, losing 13.
- From 2013 to 2018, jobs **increased by 7.3%** in Dade County, MO from 1,994 to **2,139**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 0.9%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 55.5% to 55.2% between 2013 and 2018**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.6% of Dade County, MO residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.0% below the national average), and **6.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.3% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Support Activities for Crop Production.

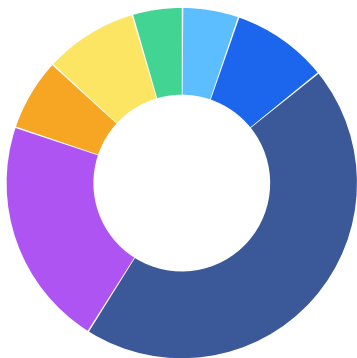

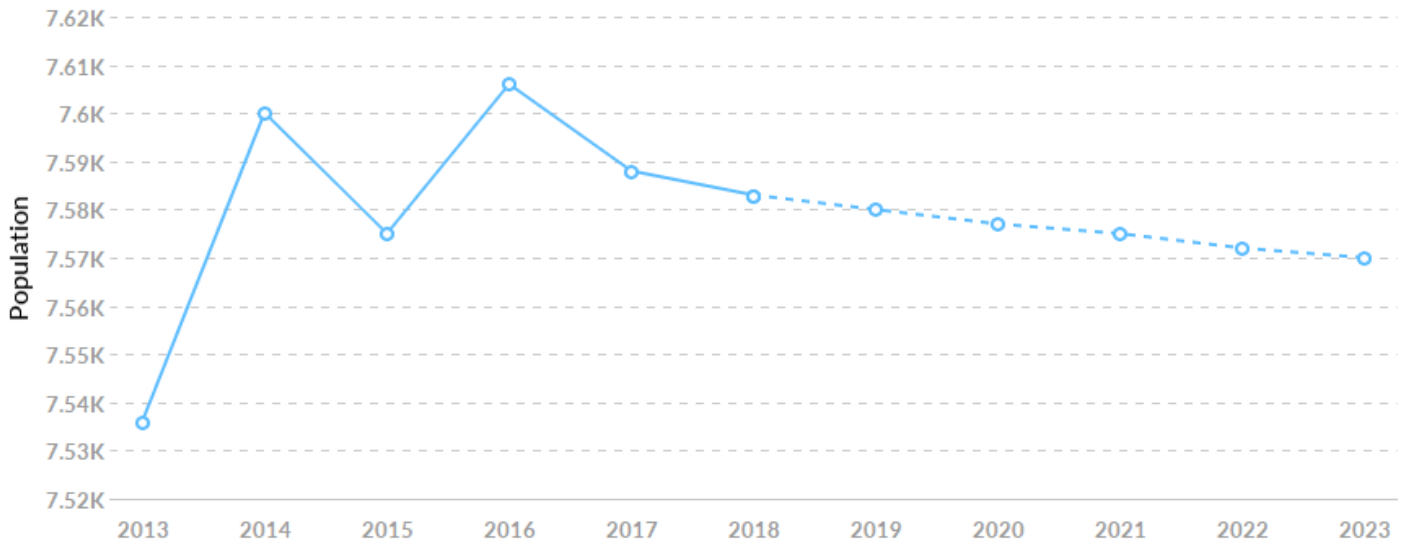

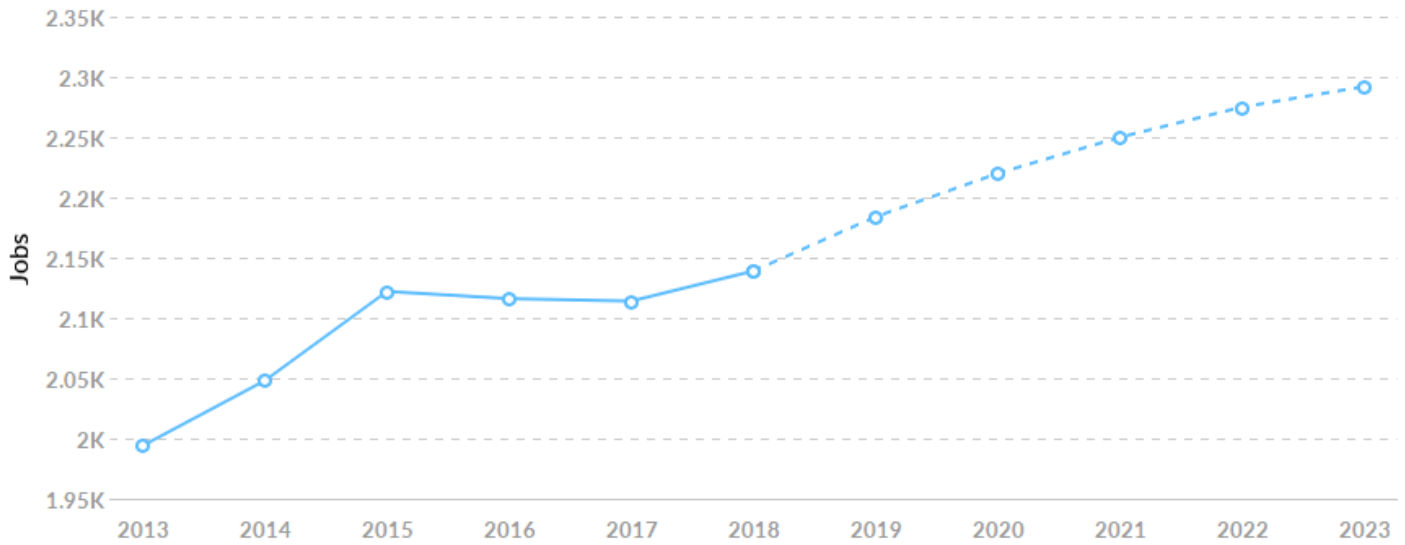

Job Trends

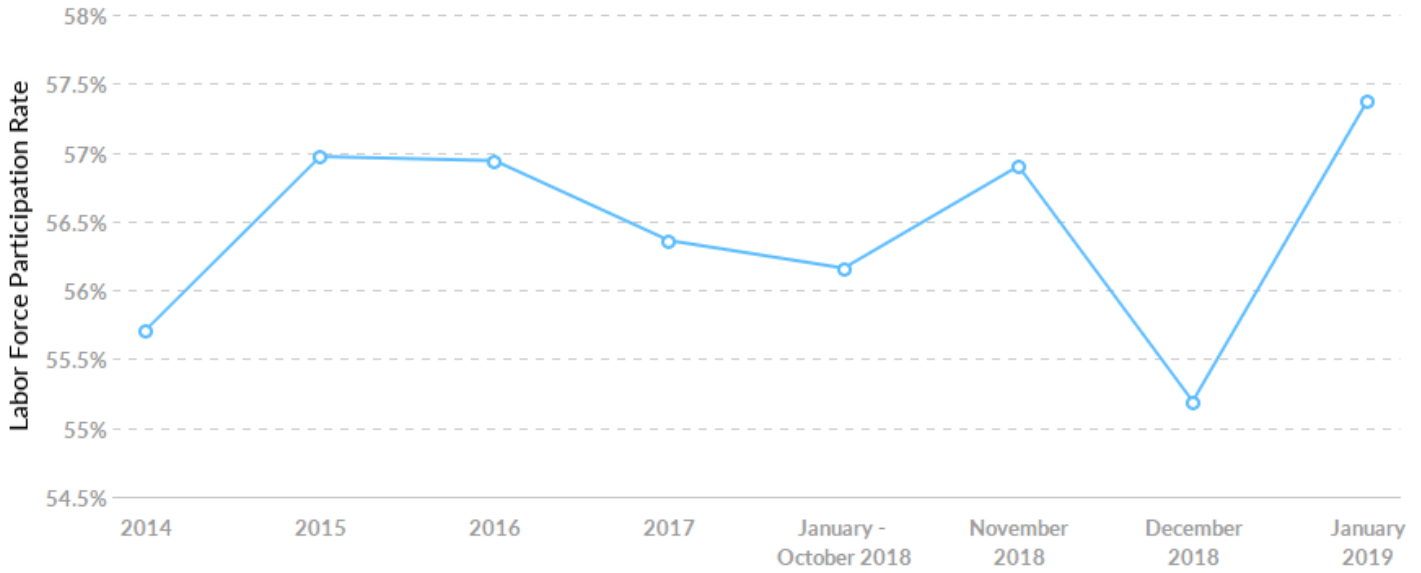

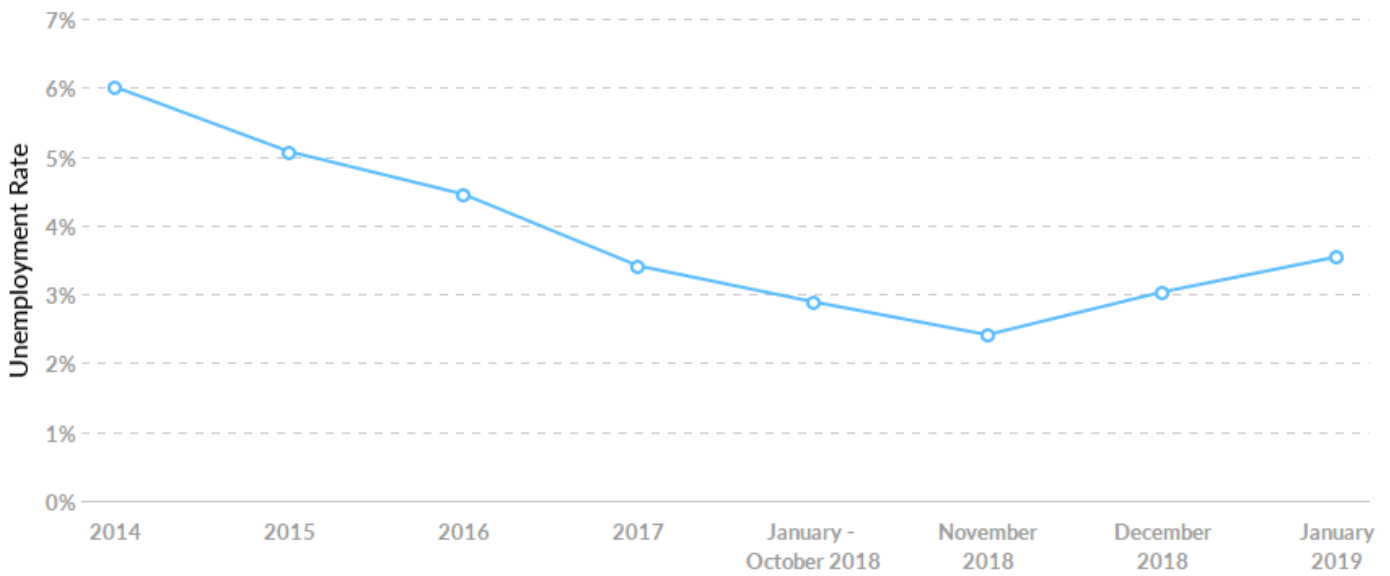

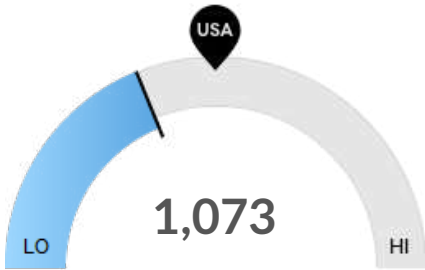
Unemployment Rate Trends

Dade County, MO had a January 2019 unemployment rate of 3.54%, **decreasing from 6.01%** 5 years before.



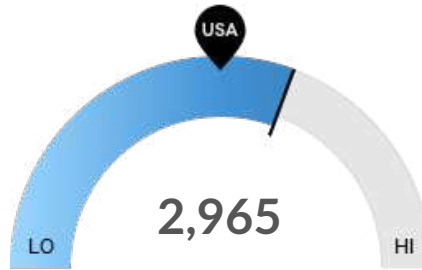

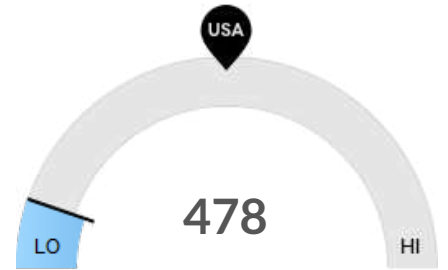
Millennials

Dade County, MO has 1,073 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 1,572.



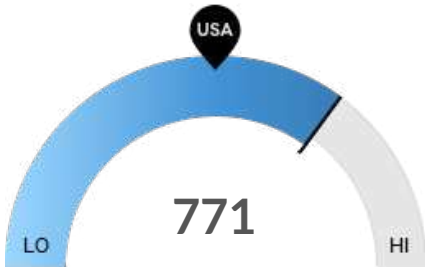
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Dade County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 2,163 people 55 or older, while there are 2,965 here.



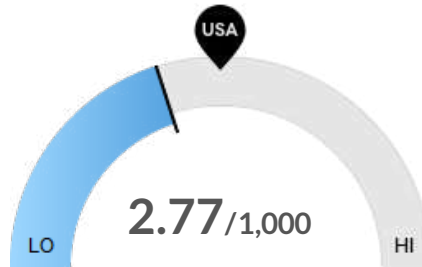
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Dade County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 2,980 racially diverse people, while there are 478 here.



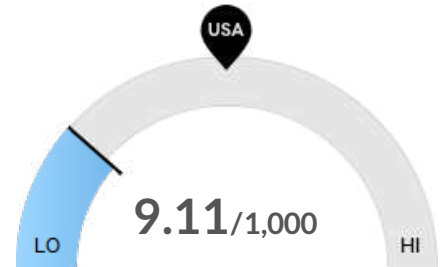
Veterans

Dade County, MO has 2.77 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.75 per 1,000 people.



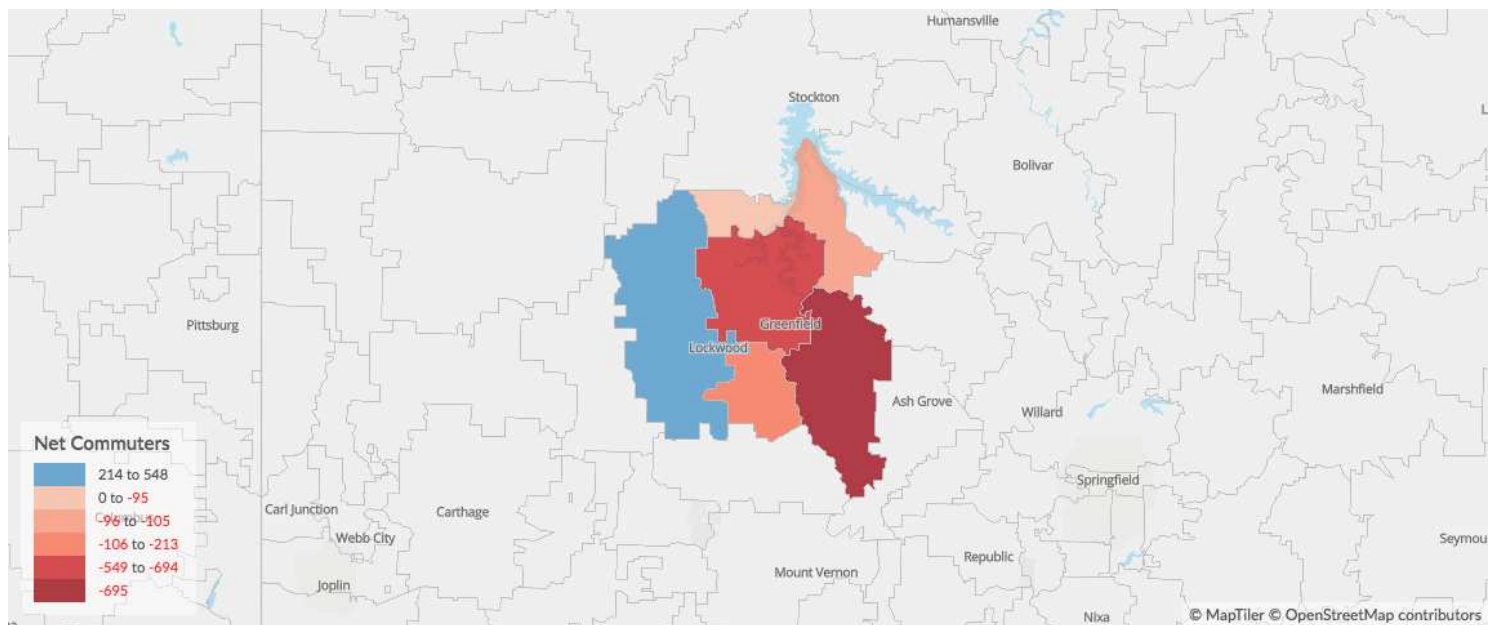
Property Crime

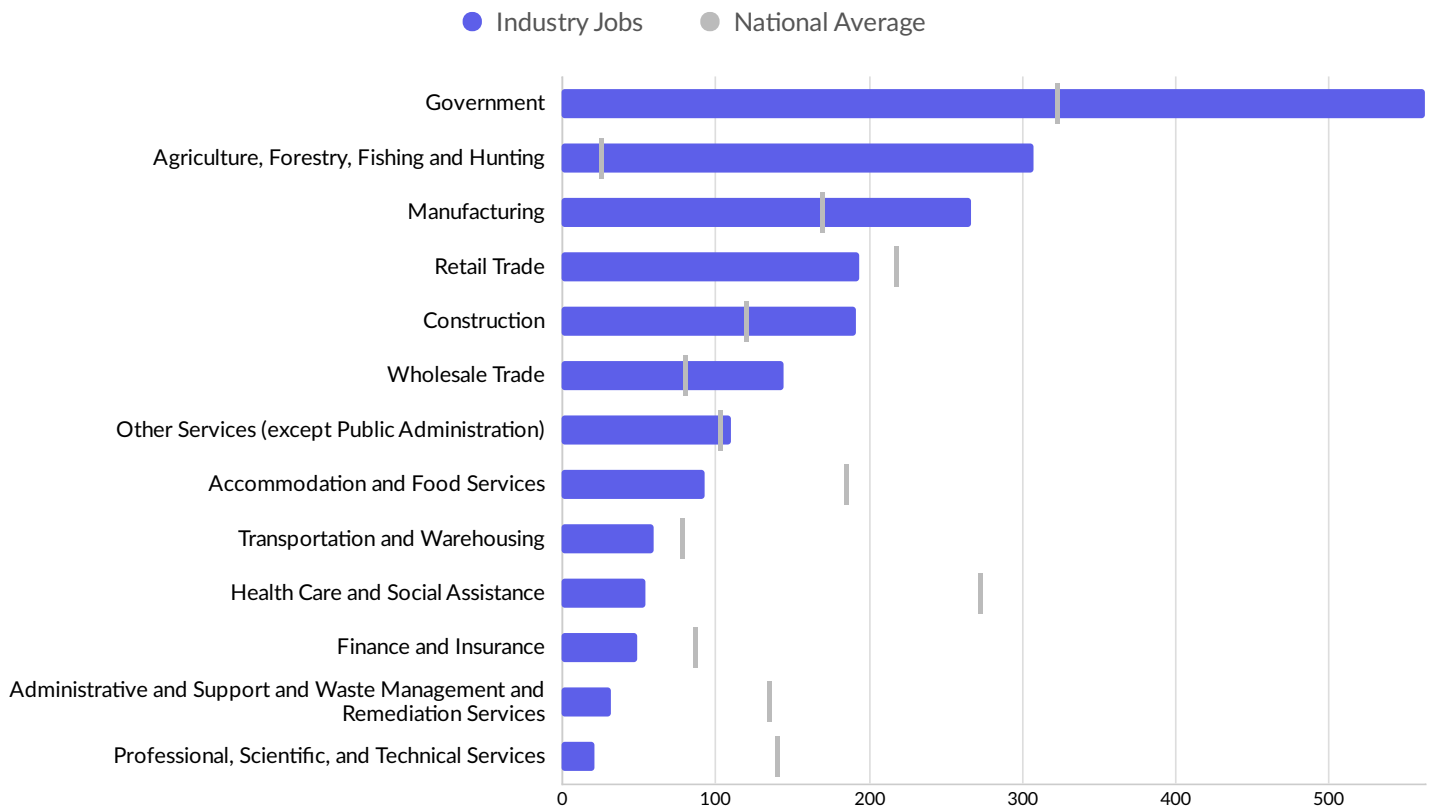

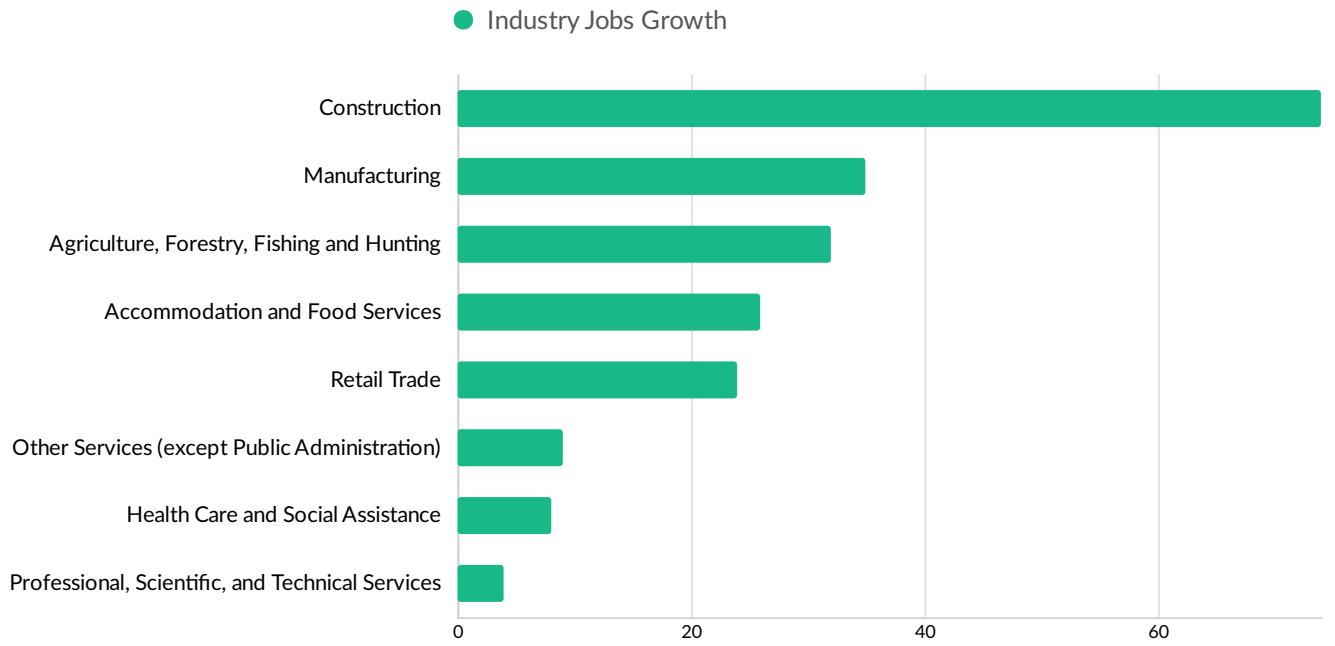

Largest Industries



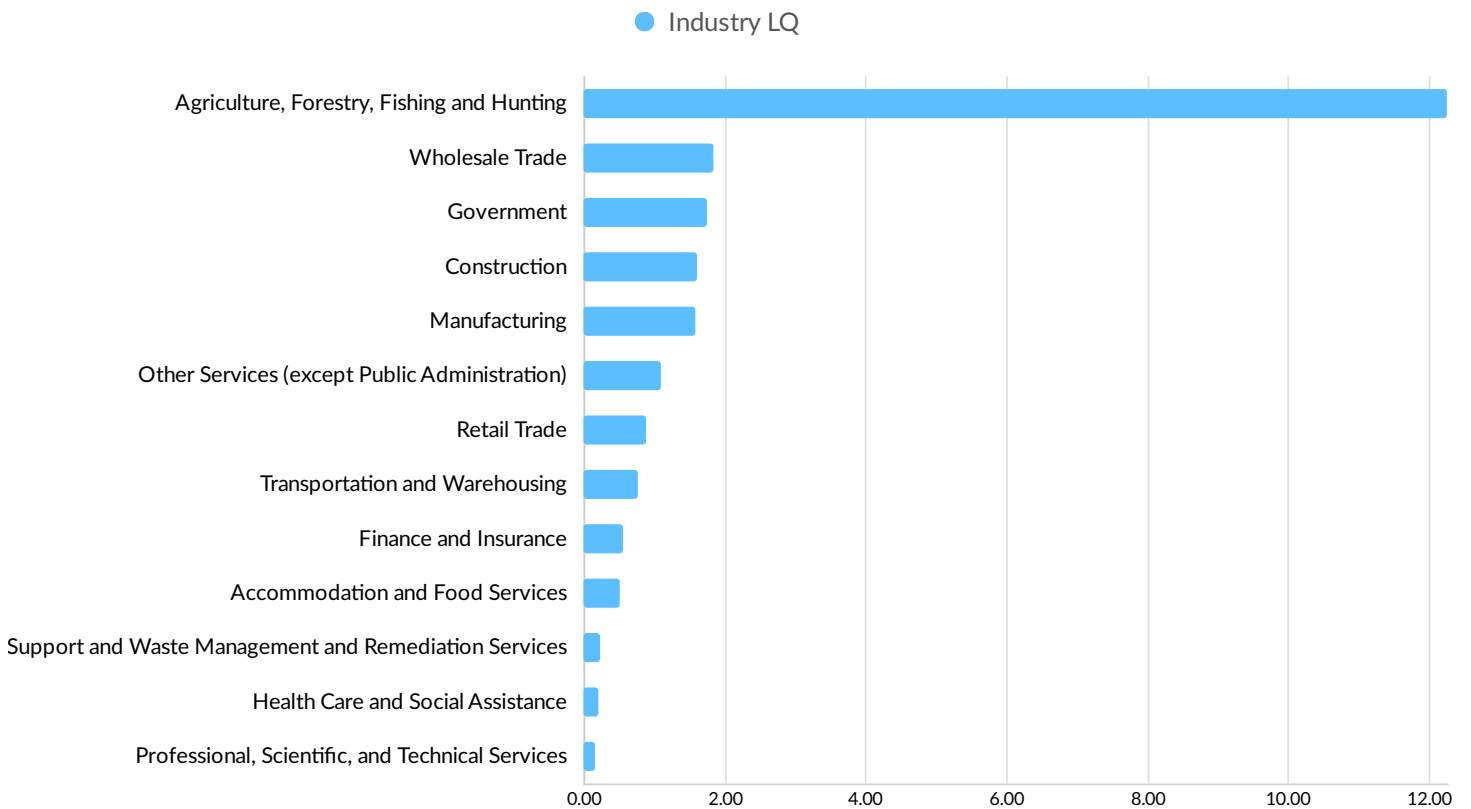

Top Growing Industries



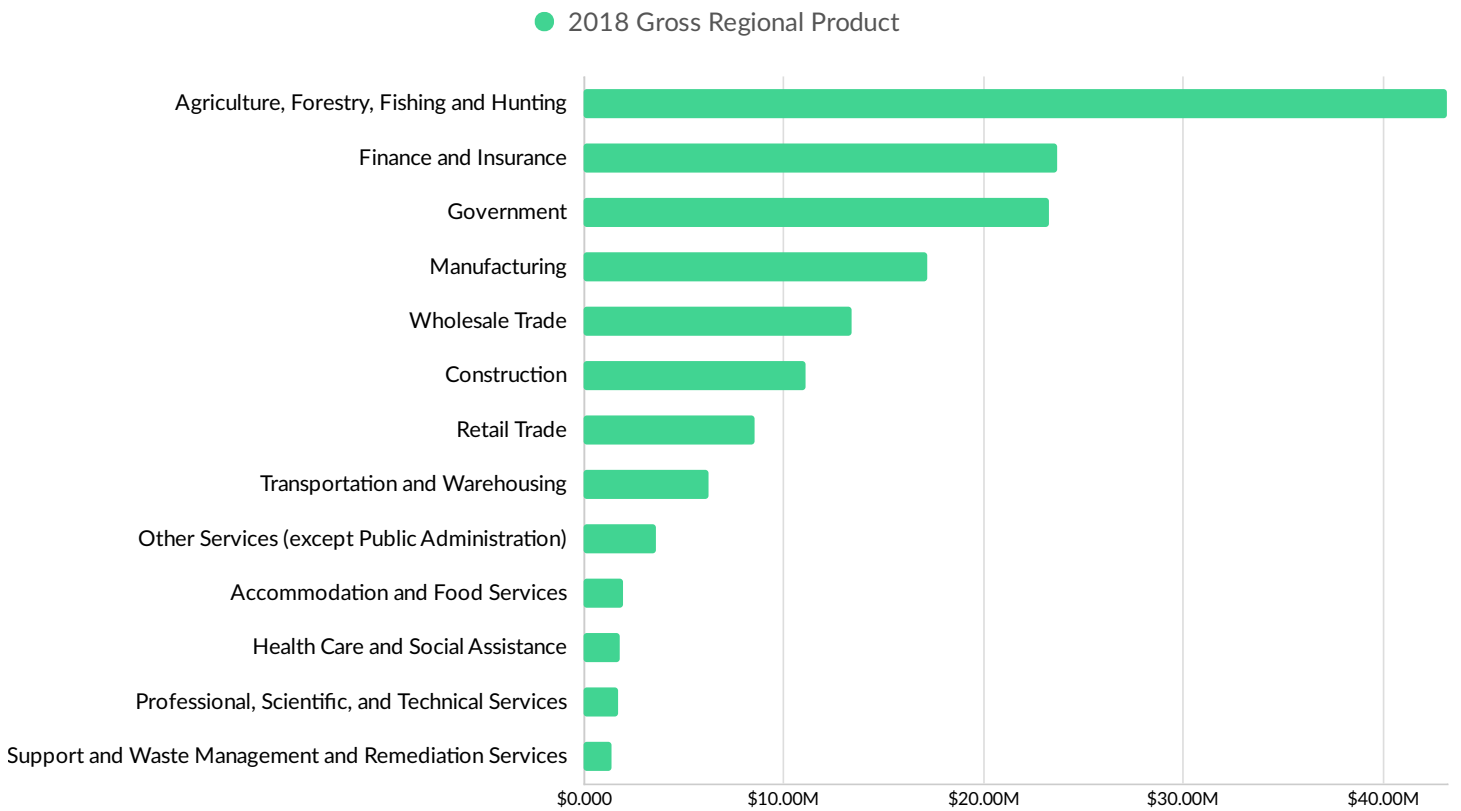

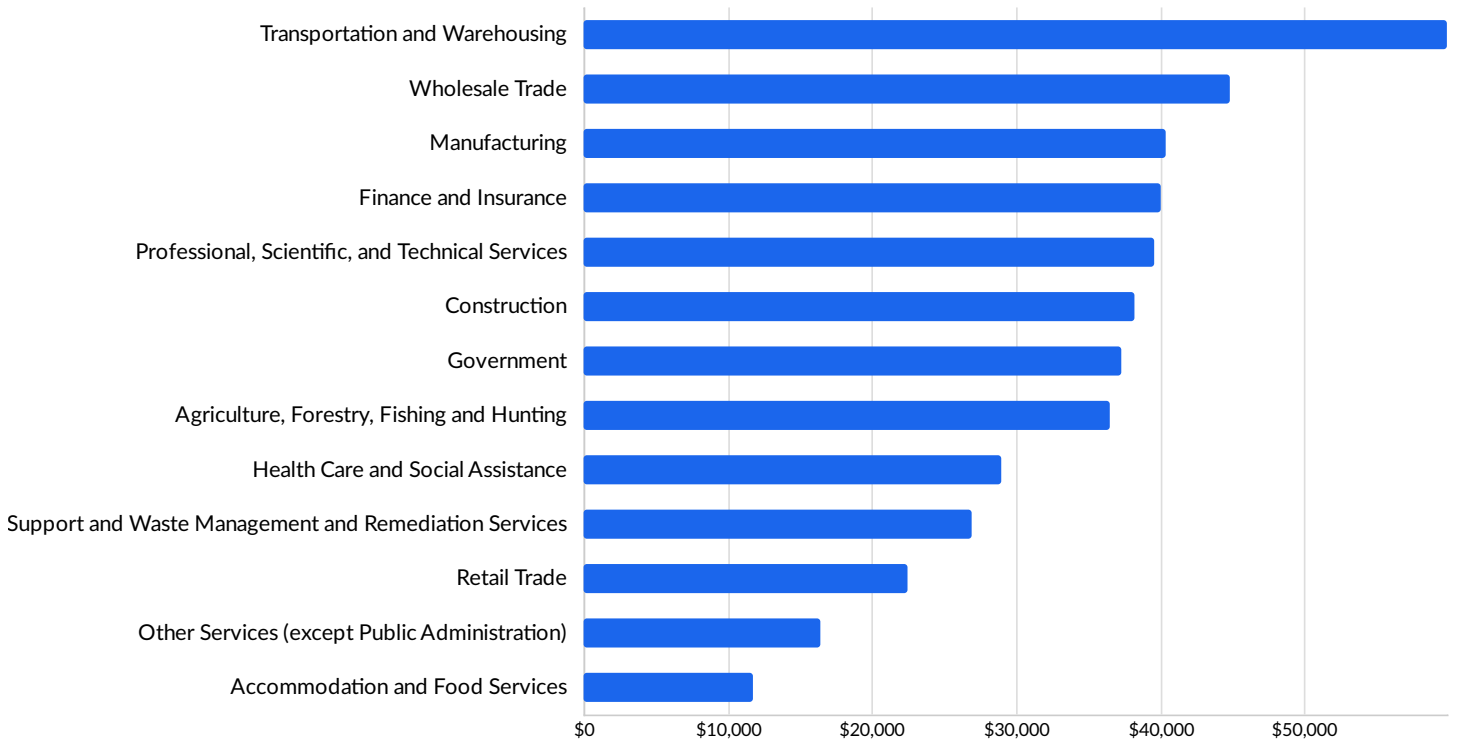
Top Industry GRP

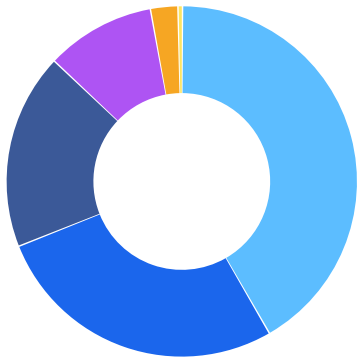

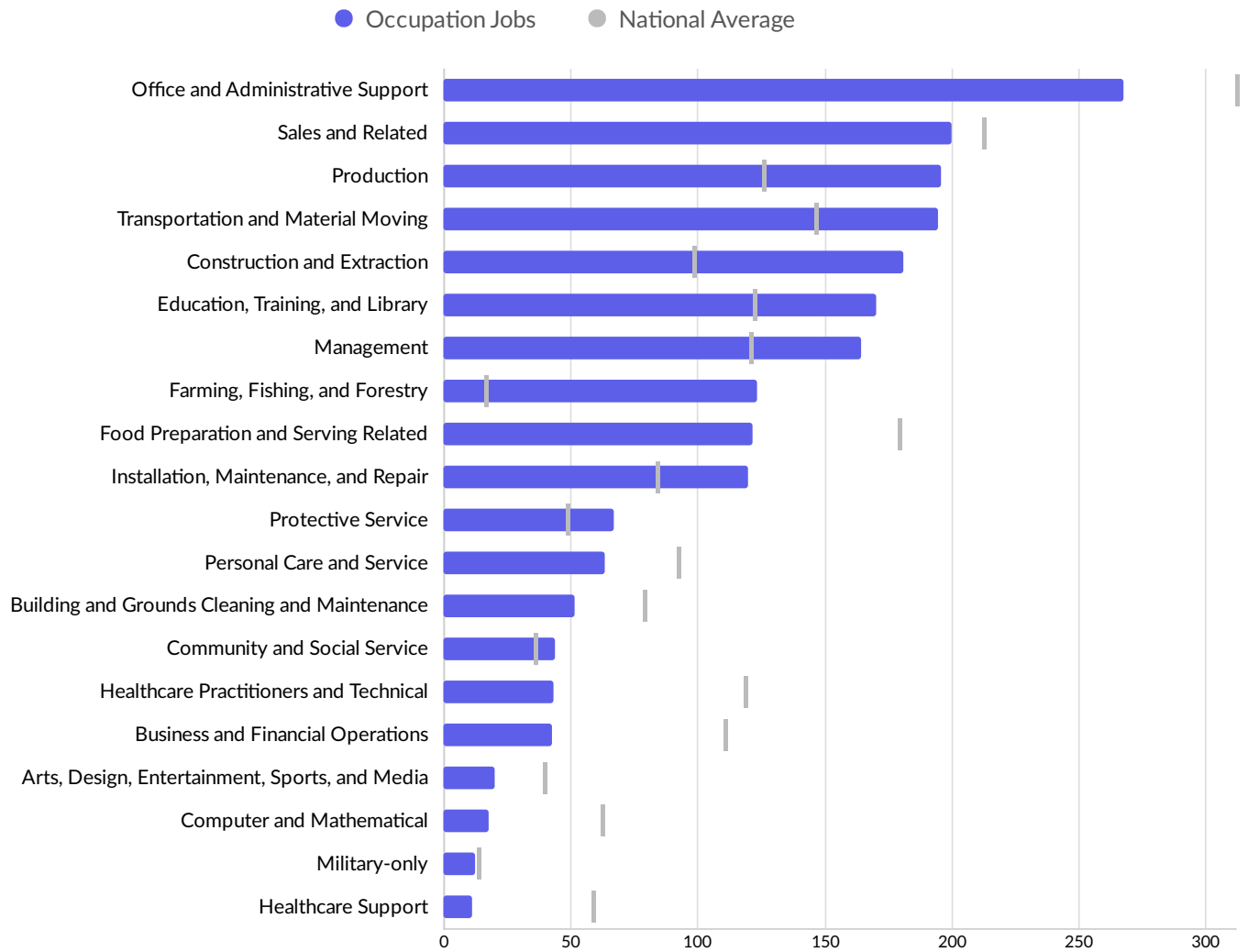

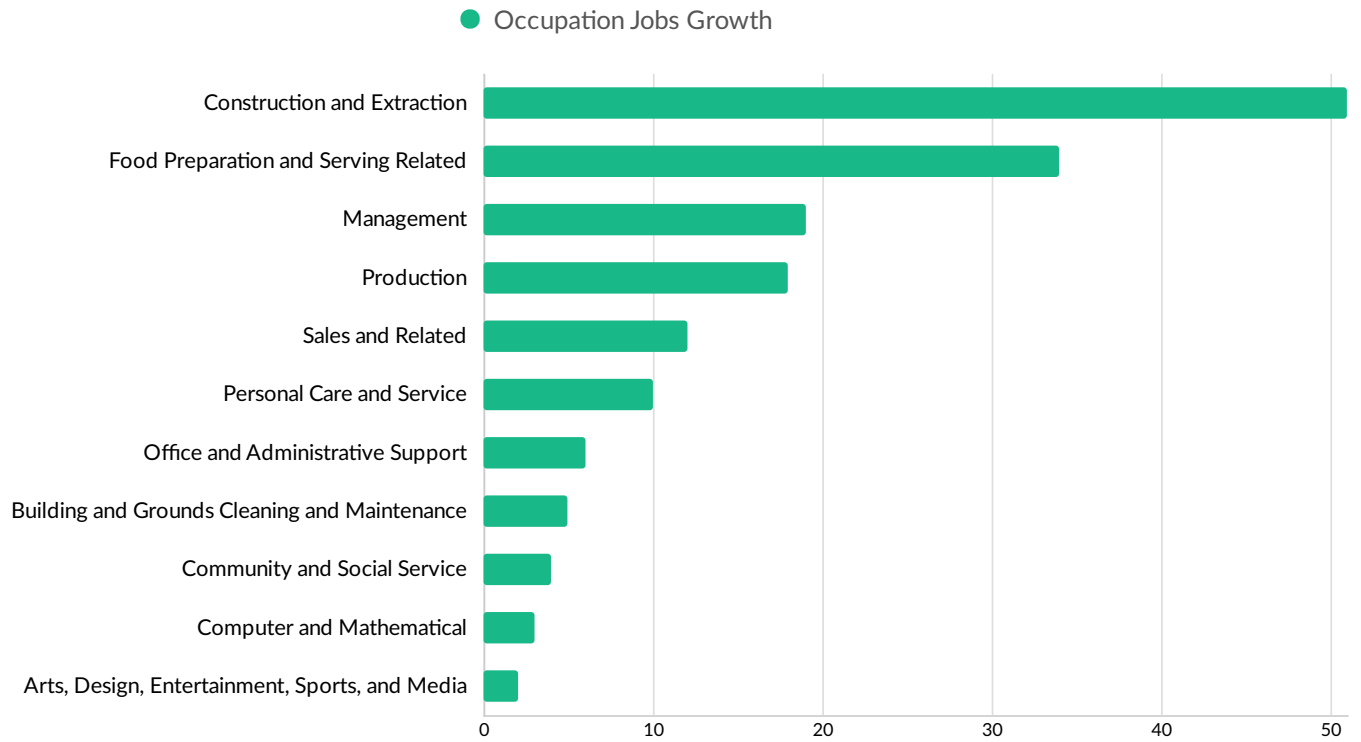

Largest Occupations



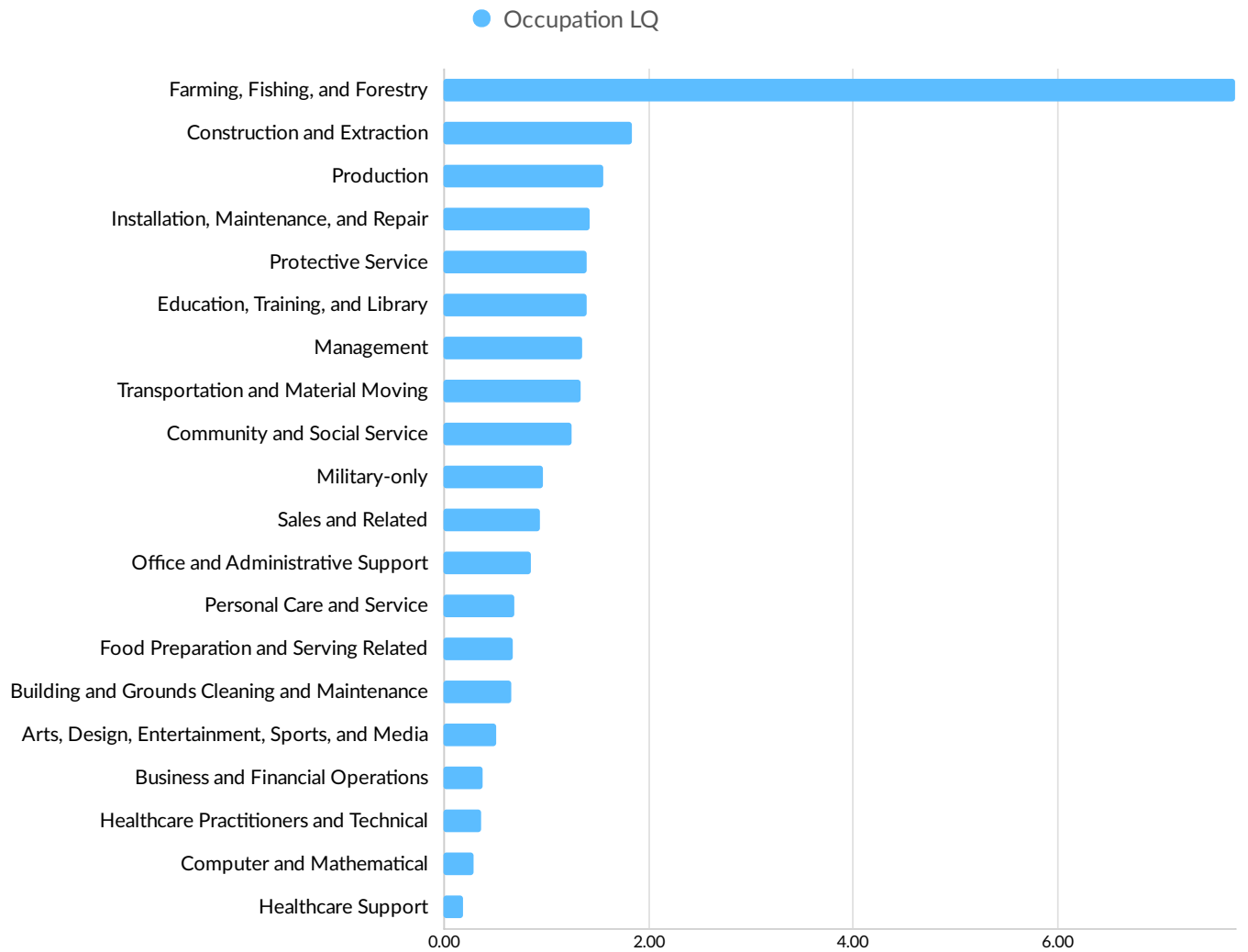

Top Occupation LQ



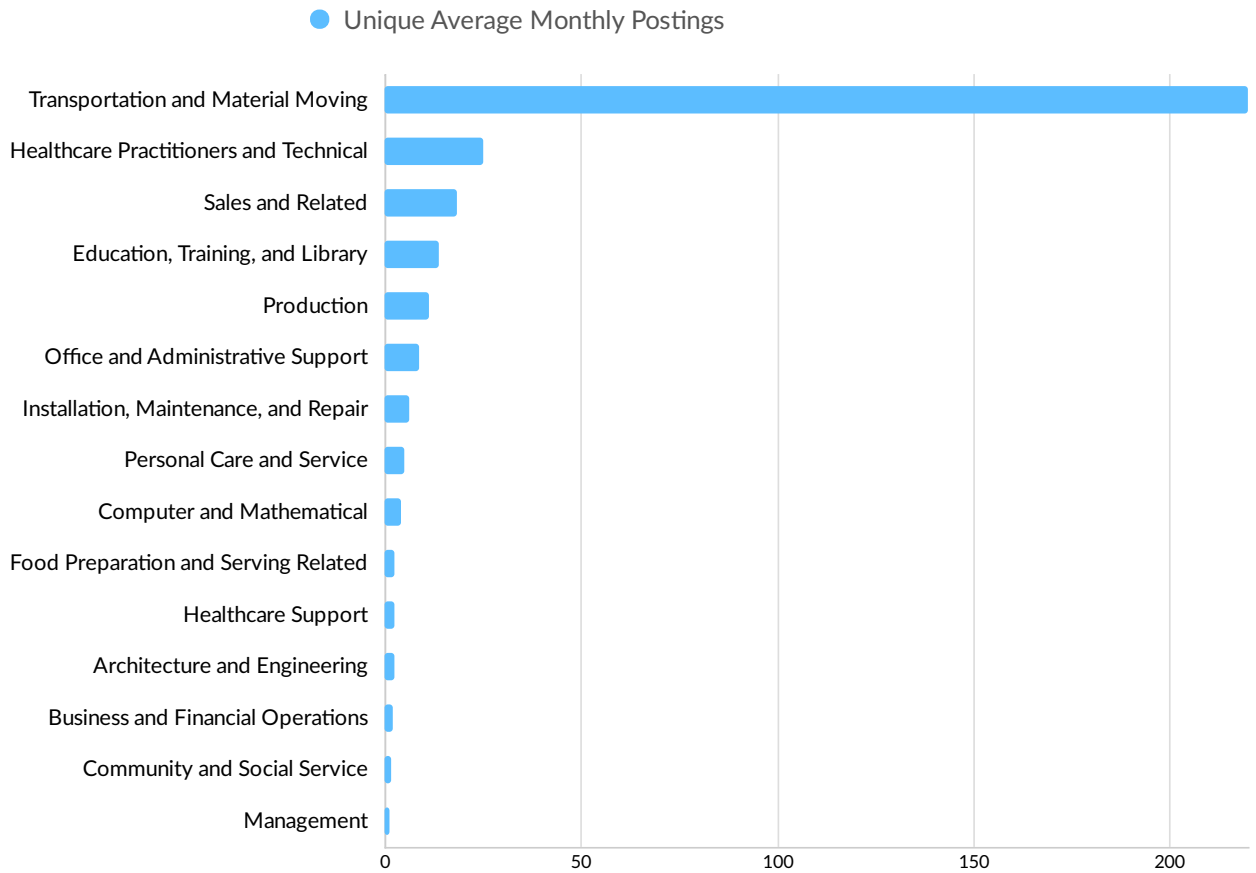

Top Occupation Earnings



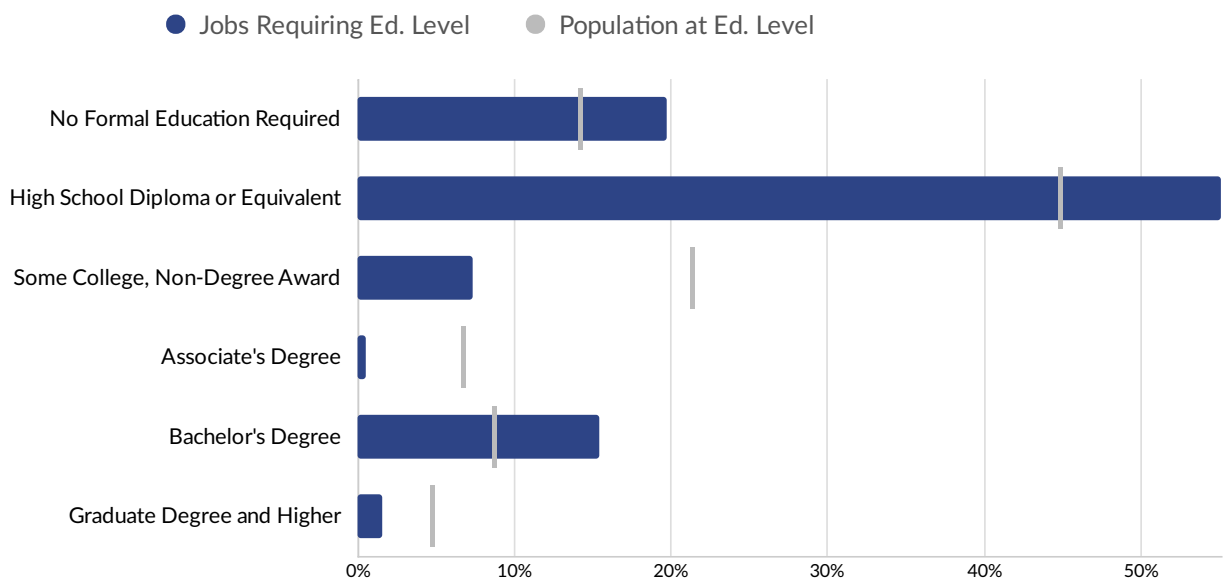
